Rules:

1. Anyone may enter.
2. Photo must include a historic structure, object or landscape that lies within the Cowell Lime Works Historic District.
2. Each entrant may submit one photo. Photo should be submitted on a CD as a jpeg file (300 dpi minimum).
3. The CD should be clearly labeled with your name, phone number and email address and "Friends of the Lime Works Photo Contest."
4. Each photo must be accompanied by an ownership waiver to provide Friends of the Lime Works with the right to publish or use your photo in publicity materials. Please download and print the waiver form at <http://limeworks.ucsc.edu>.
5. Photo, CD and waiver must be submitted by mail no later than 5 PM, November 19, to: UCSC, Friends of the Lime Works, Mail Stop: PP&C, 1156 High Street, Santa Cruz, 95064. You also may submit materials in person at the Physical Planning and Construction reception desk at the Tack House, near Barn G on the campus.

Please do not enter any unoccupied structure in the historic district.
